**ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT**

This matter is before the Court pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 22.3, upon a Notice of Submission filed by Disciplinary Counsel for the Board of Professional Responsibility consisting of a certified copy of Petition to Enter a Plea of Guilty filed in United States District Court Middle District of Tennessee Nashville Division (attached as Exhibit A), demonstrating that Brian Kirk Kelsey, a Tennessee attorney, pled guilty to two serious crimes, i.e., Conspiracy to Defraud the United States and Aiding and Abetting the Acceptance of Excessive Contributions.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

1. Brian Kirk Kelsey is suspended from the practice of law on this date pending further orders of this Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 22.3.
2. This matter shall be referred to the Board of Professional Responsibility for the institution of a formal proceeding in which the sole issue to be determined shall be the extent of the final discipline.
3. Brian Kirk Kelsey shall fully comply with the provisions of Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, concerning disbarred or suspended attorneys.
4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
